

PRESERVED COACHING STOCK OF BRITISH RAILWAYS

SPECIAL AND CHARTER TRAIN COACHING STOCK

A) English, Welsh and Scottish Railway

At the end of March the remaining operational carriages in the English, Welsh & Scottish Railway charter fleet based at Bounds Green were transferred to Old Oak Common. These being those normally included in the Green 'BN96' and Racing Green and Cream 'BN93' sets. Carriages involved being Mark 1 Catering Cars 1679, 1680, 1696, 1698, 1832; STAFF 2834; FOs 3097, 3119, 3120, 3121, 3123, 3124, 3127, 3141, 3146, 3147, 3149; TSOs 4925, 4986, 5007, 5023, 5027, 5037; BFK 17015; BCK 21269. Also making the move is Green liveried Mark 2 TSO 5482 that remains on loan to English, Welsh & Scottish Railway. Three Green Mark 1 carriages were left behind at Bounds Green, these being FO 3150, TSO 4977 and BFK 17023. These have now been taken out of use and stored at Bounds Green along with Blue & Grey liveried Mark 1 Staff 2833, FO 3115 and InterCity liveried RBR 1674. Also now out of service is Blue & Grey liveried TSO 4938 that is now in storage at Doncaster depot following a fire. Thus all operational English, Welsh & Scottish Railway charter stock is now based at Old Oak Common.

As a consequence of the fleet reductions, sets are increasingly being formed of carriages in several different liveries. These colourful combinations are expected to increase as further Mark 1 carriages are stood down.

B) West Coast Railway Company

The Company again operated its 'Jacobite' steam locomotive hauled train between Fort William and Mallaig last summer. A set of Maroon liveried Mark 1s was used consisting of RMB 1860, FO 3130(99128), TSOs 4931(99329), 4951, 4954(99326), 4958, FK 13321(99316) and BCK 21266. Support coaches at Fort William were BFK 14007 and Courier 80220.

Mark 1 TSO 4905 is no longer on loan to Vintage Trains and has been returned to Carnforth.

Mark 1 FO 3136, latterly numbered 977970, has been returned to mainline operation and numbered 3136. It is painted in Maroon livery.

C) VINTAGE TRAINS

Mark 1 TSO 4905 is no longer on loan from West Coast Railway Company and has returned to Carnforth.
