Portway Park & Ride The City of Bristol's first new station for nearly 100 years (the last being Parsons Street in 1927, otherwise the nearest was in South Gloucestershire at Filton Abbey Wood in 1996) was opened on 31st July by Transport Minister Mark Harper MP who with attending Bristol City Councillors, GWR and Network Rail officials were conveyed on 165112 with the 09.10 Bristol Temple Meads-Severn Beach normal service train calling at 09.40. Later, 166214 stopped with the 13.46 Avonmouth-Weston-super-Mare service to collect the officials that travelled by train for their return to Bristol. The following day, 1st August, saw the first public train to call 165108 on 05.00 Bristol Temple Meads-Severn Beach at 05.37, followed by 165102 with 05.37 Bristol Temple Meads-Severn Beach at 06.02 and 165108 again on the first up train to call 05.53 Severn Beach-Bristol Temple Meads at 06.07.

Avonmouth Following problems with the inward working on 31st July which involved the removal of 2 wagons and the fitting of wheel skates, the 6V70 03.02 Small Heath-Swindon Cocklebury yard scrap empties with 66750 eventually reached its destination on 2nd August via Gloucester New Yard for loading with scrap. The loaded 6M31 18.35 Swindon-Liverpool EMR again with the same loco and 19 JNA boxes, was diverted via Bristol, the Severn Tunnel and Hereford (due to an engineering blockade between Radley and Oxford) but suffered further problems with over loaded wagons and cut sheet metal waste being conveyed loose (not in the more normal compact cube form) and above the 6-inch load line beneath the wagon top. The train was reported to have lost some of its load between Wootton Bassett and Hullavington and stopped and then terminated in Bristol Parkway at 23.27 (195 minutes late). Following further safety checks the working departed at 02.04 (370 minutes late) now on 3rd August and diverted to the Avonmouth Bulk Terminal for further daylight wagon load checks to be carried out over the coming few days. With another loco, 66754 brought in from Newport as 0V01 (and 0V02 return to Cardiff Castle Works) on 9th, the train was moved over to the West Wharf container loading area in the Port of Bristol Docks (via Hallen Marsh junction) for the load to be flattened down using a road grab vehicle, the train then being finally able to proceed onwards on 13th August as 6Z73 15.00 Avonmouth-Bescot Engineers sidings.
