The 1968 Hixon Level Crossing Disaster

In this dreadful accident a huge articulated transporter lorry, carrying a 120-ton transformer slowly over the automatic level crossing at Hixon, was hit by a 500-ton express train travelling at about 75mph. It was truly a dramatic case of an irresistible force meeting an immovable object.

The terrific impact not only destroyed the electric locomotive, killing the three-man crew instantly, but also wrecked the first five coaches of the train, causing the death of eight passengers, and tore up the track and infrastructure for nearly 200 yards.

This talk will examine the accident from all perspectives and the changes which followed, plus an update of recent commemorative events in the village of Hixon and in the railway industry.

The Romance of Steam?



West Country Class 4-6-2 No. 34095 'Brentor' has its fire cleaned at Eastleigh MPD on 22 June 1967. The locomotive was withdrawn just under three weeks later at the end of the steam era on the Southern Region.

34095 was one of the British Railways built Light Pacifics being built at Eastleigh in 1949 and later rebuilt in 1961.



National Rail

On the 20th March 2024 strike action was announced by the ASLEF Union. These strikes will have an impact on our immediate area on:-

- Monday 8 April c2c, Gatwick Express, Great Northern, Greater Anglia (including Stansted Express), South Western Railway (including Island Line), Southeastern, Southern and Thameslink. London Underground drivers who are members of ASLEF are also set to go on strike on this day.
- Additionally train operators will have an overtime ban from Thursday 4 April to Saturday 6
 April, and from Monday 8 April to Tuesday 9 April.
