Please fill in your personal details at the top of the Booking Form (ignore "Organiser name") and return the completed form to Peter Wilson, 111 Chipstead Way, Banstead, SM7 3JJ, together with a non-refundable deposit of £5 per person. PLEASE NOTE: We have to confirm our booking and chosen dishes with the Porter and Sorter by Wednesday 30 November. So, in addition to posting the completed form and non-refundable deposit to Peter, please telephone or email him (details below) with your contact details and requirements by Tuesday 29 November.

Please make cheques payable to Peter Wilson and please don't send cash in the post. The balance of the cost of the meal will be payable on the night by cash or cheque.

If you don't know the Porter & Sorter, the pub is a few minutes' walk from East Croydon station, tram and bus stops, on the east side of the station in Billinton Hill (aka Station Road East), CR0 6BT, down the road and over the pedestrian crossing from the line of waiting taxis. If you need further directions please get in touch with one of us.

The next meeting in the Branch Programme will take place at East Croydon URC on Tuesday 13 December when Ian Capewell, Inspector, RAIB, will give a presentation on *The Work of the RAIB*. We had booked Ian to come to us in April 2020 but the Covid-19 lockdown required us to cancel his visit for a face to face meeting. We offered him a place in our programme of virtual meetings on Zoom instead but he much preferred to wait until he could give his presentation in person.
