5) News of Mainline Operators

i) Solar Eclipse 1999

Attached to this Amendment Sheet are details of the locomotive hauled charter trains operated to and from Cornwall and Devon in connection with the Solar Eclipse of 11th August 1999. Comments regarding the carriages used under the headings of the carriage providers follow.

i)a) Venice-Simplon Orient Express

Two sets of carriages were provided, The London based Pullman set and the Crewe based Regency Rail Cruises set. The 'Regal' Class 47s being used to head these sets. The former set was used for a series of trains that commenced in London but based on Exeter. All eleven Pullman Cars were included in the formation. The need for a temporary base at Exeter Riverside Yard resulted in fifteen of the seventeen London based carriages seeing use. Commitments for the Pullman set resulted in it returning to London in the early hours of August 12th with passengers following later in the day aboard the Regency Rail Cruises set. Six carriages of the Regency Rail Cruises set were combined with six Riviera Trains carriages to form the Crewe-Penzance train. On return to Crewe the full Regency Rail Cruises set was reformed and ran empty back to Exeter in order to operate the above mentioned train to London with the addition of Baggage Car No.8 from the London based set.

i)b) Riviera Trains

A complete Mark 1 set was provided for the Crewe-Plymouth via Birmingham train and a Mark 1/Mark 2 half set for the Crewe-Penzance train (see above). The same day also saw the company's carriages on loan to North Western Trains and Silverlink Railways which resulted in only Saloon 6320, BFK 17056 & BSK 35453 having the day off.

i)c) Scottish Railway Preservation Society

The full set of eleven 100mph carriages were used on the 'epic' Linlithgow-Penzance train. This being the furthest point from Scotland ever reached by the set and also the first appearance of 37410 on a passenger train south of Carlisle since it was fitted with ETS.

i)d) West Coast Railway Company

Two sets were provided. That for the Crewe-Plymouth via Shrewsbury train consisted of thirteen Maroon liveried Mark 1s. That for the Victoria-Plymouth train consisted of carriages in various liveries. In addition to five of the companies maroon liveried Mark 1 and 2s the train comprised of four Mark 2 Pullman Cars in red and beige livery along with RB 1659 (Umber & Cream livery) and RMB 1861 (Maroon livery) hired from Wessex Trains. This later set had run empty from Carnforth to Old Oak Common on 9th August and returned empty to Carnforth from Old Oak Common on 13th August.

i)e) Rail Charter Services

All four of the company's sets were deployed along with a 'scratch set' formed up for the event. BN91, the Carmine & Cream set, used for a Paddington-Penzance train curiously included Southern Green Open First 3150 in its formation. BN93, Pride of the Nation set, used for a Paddington-Penzance train was strengthened using three Carmine & Cream liveried carriages not formed in set BN91. BN94, the mixed Blue & Grey/InterCity liveried set was used for a Paddington-Penzance train and also included two Carmine & Cream liveried carriages not formed in set BN91. BN96, the Southern Green liveried set was used for the Preston-Penzance train. The 'scratch set' used for the Basingstoke-Truro train comprised carriages in various liveries, 1832, 3148, 3115, 4938, 4949 in Blue & Grey, 3136, 4977, 13318 in InterCity, 13341 in Waterman Railways Maroon and 35469 in Carmine & Cream. In addition Mark 2 InterCity liveried FOs 3292 & 3318 hired from Anglia Railways were included in the formation. The event saw, with the exception of a few brake and catering vehicles, the whole of the company's operational fleet in use.
