SPECIAL AND CHARTER TRAIN COACHING STOCK

A) VINTAGE TRAINS

Mark 1 SK 25729 (99314) on loan from the West Coast Railway Company has been painted into Chocolate and Cream livery, it was previously painted in Maroon livery. The remaining three Maroon liveried SKs on loan from the West Coast Railway Company, 25756 (99721), 25808 (99716) and 25862 (99718) have been exchanged for Maroon liveried Mark 1 TSOs 4905, 4960 and 4973.

B) WEST COAST RAILWAY COMPANY

Mark 1 SK 25729 (99314) currently on loan to Vintage Trains has been painted into Chocolate and Cream livery, it was previously painted in Maroon livery. The other three Maroon liveried SKs on loan to Vintage Trains, 25756 (99721), 25808 (99716) and 25862 (99718) have returned to Carnforth. Their place has been taken by Maroon liveried Mark 1 TSOs 4905, 4960 and 4973 now on loan to Vintage Trains.

The eight carriages provided to Valley Lines for use on additional and strengthened trains operating between Cardiff and Bargoed/Rhymney, Mark 1 TSOs 3766 (99317), 4912 (99318), 5033 (99328), 5035, 5044 (99327), 25806 (99722), Mark 1 BSK 35459 (99723) and Mark 2 BSO 9448 have now returned to Carnforth.

The carriages in use on West Highland steam services this summer are Mark 1s RMB 1860, FO 3130 (99128) TSOs 4931 (99329), 4940, 4954 (99326), 4958 and BCK 21256 (99304). These are the same seven carriages as used in 1999. Also located at Fort William are Courier 80217, the support coach for 75014, and 35317 acting as support coach for 61264. The latter carriage is owned by Wessex Trains and has recently been repainted in Green livery.

C) RAIL CHARTER SERVICES

Four carriages have been loaned to Serco Railtest Ltd at Derby for use as Brake Force Runners. These are FO 3136 painted in Inter City livery, TSO 5002 painted in Dark Maroon livery, FK 13318 painted in Inter City livery and FK 13341 painted in Dark Maroon livery.

It was reported in Amendment Sheet Number 43 that STAFF 2834 was to be painted into Blue & Grey livery. This should have referred to STAFF 2833 that has now been painted into Blue & Grey livery. STAFF 2834 is painted in Lined Purple Lake livery and is not earmarked for painting in the near future. Now painted into Blue & Grey livery is TSO 4998, this was previously painted in Inter City livery.

The result of recent paintings is that only Inter City liveried RB 1674 and FO 3149 are currently in use in former liveries.

It will be noted in the following that TSOs 4869 and 4909 that were in storage at Ferme Park have been disposed of. These two carriages were damaged in the Camden derailment of 14th December 1995 and have not seen use since. Of the other carriages involved in this incident only TSO 5042 has not either been returned to use or disposed of.

D) RIVERIA TRAINS LTD

Stored Mark 2s FO 3223 and TSO 5879 have been moved from Old Oak Common to Crewe Carriage Shed.
