SPECIAL AND CHARTER TRAIN COACHING STOCK

A) RAIL CHARTER SERVICES

The final Carmine and Cream liveried carriage, FO 3119, has now been painted into Green livery. Thus the Carmine and Cream livery is now obsolete with this company. Liveries now carried by the companies operational Mark 1 carriages are:-Blue Generator 6311 Blue & Grey RB 1658, RMB 1832, STAFF 2833, FO 3107, 3115, 3148, TSO 4938, 4956, 4959, 4991, 4998, 4999, 5002, 5005, BCK 21246 Brtish Racing Green & Cream RB 1680, 1698, STAFF 2834, FO 3097, 3120, 3121, 3141, 3146, 3147, 3149, BCK 21269 RB 1679, 1696, FO 3114, 3119, 3123, 3124, 3127, 3150, TSO 4925, 4977, Green 4986, 5007, 5023, 5027, 5037, BFK 17015, 17023 InterCity RB 1674 RB 1671, RMB 1813, FO 3100, 3110, 3131, 3132, 3133, 3144, TSO 4915, Maroon 4916, 4946, 4949, 4996, 5008, BCK 21245, BSKgenerator 35469, RK80041

B) WEST COAST RAILWAY COMPANY

Three Mark 2E TSOs, 5853, 5869 and 5874, fitted with secondary door locks have been acquired from HSBC Rail (UK). These have now been painted Maroon at Cardiff Cathays and are to be hired to Valley Lines. Also to be hired to Valley Lines is Mark 2D BFK 17168 (99319), this is currently being fitted with secondary door lock equipment at Carnforth prior to its move to South Wales. This will mean that twelve of the companies Mark 2s are hired to Valley Lines, this will allow the operation of three four carriage sets.

Mark 1 Courier 80204 has been acquired from the Midland Railway Centre. It has been painted Maroon and has entered mainline service.

C) RIVIERA TRAINS

Several carriages have been sold, these are Mark 1 TSOs 5025 & 5030 to the West Somerset Railway, Mark 2 TSO 5462 and FK 13585 to the East Lancashire Railway and Mark 2 BSK 35508 to Ian Riley Engineering. The latter will be based at the East Lancashire Railway and it is intended that it will be used as a locomotive support coach.

The company has established a second operating base at Old Oak Common, London and now has twenty-eight carriages based there. These are Mark 1 RB 1683 & 1699, Mark 2 FO 3181, 3188, 3223, 3228, 3240 & 3244, TSO 5276, 5292, 5322, 5341, 5366 & 5647, BFK 17086 and Couchette/Generator 17105 all previously based at Crewe and Mark 2 TSO 5748, 5752, 5769, 5776, 5792, 5794, 5796, 5814, 5816 & 5843 and Mark 1 BG(NHA) 92936 recently leased from HSBC Rail (UK). Finally, Mark 1 BSK 35461, that is used as support coach for 5029 'NUNNEY CASTLE' is also now based at Old Oak Common.
