SPECIAL AND CHARTER TRAIN COACHING STOCK

Special Note:-

In order to try and clear up some confusion that has arisen with regard to the ownership of carriages mentioned in this section. Also in order avoid future confusion. The following should be noted.

Although it is often implied that the company in the heading is the owner of a carriage this may not be strictly correct. The legal owner in reality could, for example, be a subsidiary company, an associate company or a finance company. The company in the heading is however that responsible for all aspects relating to the carriage in the context of this section and is thus considered to be the owner.

Carriages that are leased by the companies in the headings in this section, from the principal ROSCOs, HSBC Rail (UK) and Porterbrook Leasing Company, are normally referred to as leased. It is however possible other carriages are subject to lease arrangements on which information is not in the public domain.

1) West Coast Railway Company

In Amendment Sheet 75 it was stated that the Company had acquired Pullman Cars Parlour Second with Kitchen CAR No.335, Parlour Seconds CAR No.348 and CAR No.353 and Bar Car The HADRIAN BAR from Tyseley Locomotive Works. This was slightly incorrect in that although CAR No. 348 and The HADRIAN BAR had been acquired CAR No.335 and CAR No.353 remained in the ownership of Vintage Trains. The later two did however move to Carnforth for overhaul before seeing use on the National Rail network. Thus the note regarding the re-acquisition of CAR No.335 and CAR No.353 by Vintage Trains in Amendment Sheet 76 should be disregarded.

2) Vintage Trains

In Amendment Sheets 76/77 it was stated that Pullman Parlour Second with Kitchen 'CAR No. 335' and Pullman Parlour Second 'CAR No. 353' had been acquired from the West Coast Railway Company. This was not correct as the two carriages had remained in the ownership of Vintage Trains whilst at Carnforth where they were overhauled for use on the National Rail network.
